A Word From The President...



Greetings!

Another year and accomplishments by the historical society to date have been great!

At the end of 2012 a Saturday Open House was held for the unveiling of the 4th addition to the permanent photo gallery, “Santas of Saukville” and it was quite a hit! Over 60 family members and friends attended, delighting in the pictorial memories of Christmas and the men who made them “merry”. (NOTE: These gallery photos are designed for more picture additions and we are pleased to consider all submissions for inclusion.) The newest photo to the gallery is “Saukville School Days”. We are hoping the addition will be ready for unveiling by December 16, 2013.

In March 2013, a 10-week guided autobiography classes were underway, presented by Patty Tomaszewski. With success of the first class two more were added for summer and fall. We are pleased to announce with enough interest, more classes will be held in 2014.

June was education to history preservation in a two-day workshop by archival specialist Rick Starr. Teaching us proper cleaning and storage of old photos gave insight in preserving our personal collection as well as for the society.

It is our fondest hope with Village of Saukville room tax donations, specifically for instructor fees, we can institute more programs of this nature.

Late last year the Saukville St. Henrietta Court 789 of the National Catholic Society of Foresters gifted us with \$1,000 matching funds from the profit of last year’s Holiday Bake Sale & Gift Bazaar! With this donation we were able to rekindle the “Saukville’s Historic Walking Tour”

by adding permanent markers to each historic site in the village. These markers correlate with the Walking Tour Brochure created many years ago by then village board member, Donna D’Angelo and with the help of Dorothy Klein. In early Spring 2014 after markers are in place there will be a special tour date set aside for re-introducing the tour. Watch for announcements in the Ozaukee Press.

This year has also seen brick and mortar improvements to the building as well. Thanks to members, Gene Linden and Bill Kupkovits a new ceramic tiled bathroom floor has been laid and a period pedestal sink due for installation will be happening soon.

Maintenance is a major part of the society. Without the efforts and dedication of these men, preservation of Saukville’s historic treasures would not be possible. My thanks and gratitude to all our loyal members who share their time and talents in preserving the historic legacy to our community.






