Sally is going to find out if we would have adequate booth space there, and if there would be a charge to us for that space. It was suggested that instead of carrying Christmas items to the Legion Hall on the day of their bazaar, perhaps we could just open the Firehouse on that day and sell Christmas paper products. We could advertise their bazaar with signage at the Firehouse and they could advertise our sale with signage at the Legion hall. Members expressed concern with having to carry our Christmas items to the Legion hall and then having to carry any unsold items back to the Firehouse. This discussion has been tabled until the June meeting when Sally will provide us with more information from the Legion.

The Pioneer Village Handiwork event is scheduled for June 9, 2019. We will not be participating this year because we don't feel we have the necessary talent or preparation time to be part of this event.

We need to set up some dates to organize, document and catalog on-site artifacts of the Firehouse collection. It was decided to designate every Thursday in June from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Members could give as much time each Thursday as their schedules allow. We hope to have the organization and documentation of the collection completed by the end of June. We need an updated list for insurance purposes and also for our own personal information. Since we will need access to the building every Thursday, a discussion of the front door keys to the building was addressed. Anne Kertscher, Sally and Bill Kupvits, and Cindy Douglas have the keys right now. Wester Garage will also be coming to check and tune up the garage door. At this time the garage door combination will be changed.
