OLD BUSINESS:

Our focus for this meeting was to continue to discuss and implement the SAHS ideas handout prepared by Nancy Byers at our last meeting on June 21, 2021.

Mary Boyle is continuing to look at possible workshops this Fall to keep the Saukville Crossroad Rendezvous relevant and "alive" during 2021. The tourism grant of \$2500 from the Village Board could be used to pay for some scheduled events this Fall.

The 500 Tri-fold flyers are almost completed. These flyers would make the community aware of our organization, its mission, its activities and other pertinent information. The flyers will include the SAHS E-mail.

Several of our members attended the Village Board meeting held on Tuesday, July 6, 2021. It was interesting to note that several of the board members were unfamiliar with the Firehouse museum. It was agreed that the representatives from the SAHS would be given 10 minutes to discuss the events at the museum during the monthly Village board meetings. The board proposed holding one monthly meeting in September or October at the Firehouse Museum. This would certainly be a way to introduce the board members to this historical site.

Judie Jacoby contacted the Oscar Grady library requesting the use of a meeting room for the months of January, February and March. We could accomplish more if we continued our work during the entire year. The library was very accommodating and would provide a room for us. We need to now ask the library if they would have a place to display a poster board headlined DID YOU KNOW? featuring our village leaders, their family history in Saukville, etc. (See minutes for June 21, 2021 for complete explanation of this plan.)

By moving the meeting time to 6:30 p.m. we were hoping to encourage more members to attend. However, there was no increase in attendance, but to be fair, we need to give this new meeting time a chance in the next months.
